1. How many children are there in one class? What is the teacher/student ratio in school?

2. What is the age criteria for Admission?

Nursery: 3+ years

LKG: 4+ years

UKG: 5+ years

Class I: 6+ years, and so forth, with an additional year added for each subsequent class.

Please ensure that the child meets the required age criteria by exceeding the specified age as of March 31st of the academic session for which admission is being sought.
